PROCLAMATION LAW ENFORCEMENT WEEK

WHEREAS, in 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a Presidential Proclamation that set aside May 15th as National Peace Officers' Memorial Day and the week of May 15-21 as National Police Week; *and*

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers, past and present, have faithfully and loyally rendered a dedicated service to this County and have established for themselves an enviable and enduring reputation to preserving the rights and security of all citizens.

THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Rowan County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim May 15-21, 2023 as **LAW ENFORCEMENT WEEK**.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that the Rowan County Board of Commissioners calls upon all citizens of Rowan County to observe May 17, 2023 as **PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL DAY** in honor of those law enforcement officers who, through their courageous deeds, have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their community, or, have become disabled in the performance of duty, and let us recognize and pay respect to the survivors of our fallen heroes.
