# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE ROWAN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS April 16, 2018 – 6:00 PM J. NEWTON COHEN, SR. ROOM J. NEWTON COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING

Present: Greg Edds, Chairman Jim Greene, Vice-Chairman Mike Caskey, Member Judy Klusman, Member Craig Pierce, Member

County Manager Aaron Church, Clerk to the Board/Assistant to the County Manager Carolyn Barger, County Attorney Jay Dees and Assistant County Manager/Finance Director Leslie Heidrick were present.

Chairman Edds convened the meeting at 6:00 p.m.

Chaplain Michael Taylor provided the Invocation.

Chairman Edds led the Pledge of Allegiance.

# CONSIDER ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

# 3. PRESENTATION OF PLAQUE FOR HISTORIC NEELY SCHOOL

(This item was changed in the order of discussion to agenda item #3c).

# **ADDITIONS**

# 3a. PROCLAMATION TO ESTABLISH MAY AS SHIELD-A-BADGE WITH PRAYER AWARENESS MONTH

(This item was pulled from the Consent Agenda for discussion).

Chairman Edds called Reverend Michael Taylor forward to discuss the



Proclamation to Establish May as Shield-A-Badge With Prayer Awareness Month (Proclamation).

Reverend Taylor, who also serves as Chaplain for the Rowan County Sheriff's Department, thanked the Board for its support of the Shield-A-Badge With Prayer Program (Program), which was in its 23<sup>rd</sup> year. Rev. Taylor said there were approximately 500 prayer partners across Rowan and other counties that had committed to pray for officers through the Program. Chaplain Taylor said many officers lives had been saved or remained uninjured due to people praying for those officers.

Rev. Taylor described the Program as simple and said prayer partners were asked to send a birthday card to an officer, as well as another card during the second week of May. Rev. Taylor concluded by saying all officers deserve the prayers and it was also his prayer the Program would expand across the United States.

A round of applause followed Rev. Taylor's comments.

Chairman Edds moved approval of the Proclamation To Establish May As Shield-A-Badge With Prayer Awareness Month. Chairman Edds read the Proclamation as follows:

WHEREAS, the Shield-A-Badge With Prayer program works to affirm the commitment of Rowan County Law Enforcement Officers and encourages citizen awareness and appreciation for these officers; and

WHEREAS, the program invites citizens to commit to pray for an officer every day for one year and to send birthday cards and notes of thanks to these officers; and

WHEREAS, through the generosity of individuals, businesses and churches that have donated services and fundraisers, 10,000 Bibles, 3,700 Shield-A-Badge Bible Promise Books and 11,000 New Testaments have been purchased to be given away; and

WHEREAS, the Shield-A-Badge With Prayer program began in 1995 in Rowan County, by Chaplain Michael Taylor and has begun to expand statewide, reaching out to other counties, municipalities, colleges, hospitals, correctional facilities, 911 communicators, probations officers, animal control officers, state highway patrol troopers, fire departments, Clerk of Court employees, magistrates, judges, District Attorney's Office, County Commissioners, sheriffs, and attorneys; and

WHEREAS, through the dedication and travels of Chaplain Taylor, counties from across the state are receiving encouragement and training for chaplains.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Rowan County Board of Commissioners does hereby establish the month of May as Shield-A-Badge With Prayer Awareness Month.

The motion to approve the Proclamation was seconded by Commissioner Pierce and passed unanimously.

#### 3b. PROCLAMATION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT WEEK

(This item was pulled from the Consent Agenda for discussion).



Commissioner Caskey took a moment to thank Reverend Taylor, who serves as Chaplain of the Rowan County Sheriff's Department, for ensuring the Proclamation For Law Enforcement Week was on the Board's agenda each year. Commissioner Caskey said over the past few years there had been a big change in the law enforcement community. Commissioner Caskey, who is a law enforcement officer in Mecklenburg County, said most deputies wanted to make a difference and signed up to be in law enforcement with good intentions. Commissioner Caskey said officers do not choose their profession for the money.

Commissioner Caskey moved approval of the Proclamation for Law Enforcement Week, which he read as follows:

WHEREAS, in 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a Presidential Proclamation that set aside May 15<sup>th</sup> as National Peace Officers' Memorial Day and the week of May 13-19 as National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, the members of all the law enforcements agencies in Rowan County play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of all our citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens know and understand the duties, responsibilities, hazards and sacrifices of their law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, members of our law enforcement agencies recognize their duty to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, by protecting them against violence and disorder, and by protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against oppression; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers, past and present, have faithfully and loyally rendered a dedicated service to this County and have established for themselves an enviable and enduring reputation to preserving the rights and security of all citizens.

THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Rowan County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim May 13-19, 2018 as LAW ENFORCEMENT WEEK.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that the Rowan County Board of Commissioners calls upon all citizens of Rowan County to observe May 15, 2018 as PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL DAY in honor of those law enforcement officers who, through their courageous deeds, have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to their community or have become disabled in the performance of duty, and let us recognize and pay respect to the survivors of our fallen heroes.

The motion to approve the Proclamation was seconded by Commissioner Pierce and carried unanimously.

# 3c. PRESENTATION OF PLAQUE FOR HISTORIC NEELY SCHOOL

(This item was changed in the order of discussion from agenda item #3 to #3c).

Chairman Edds said on October 16, 2017 the Board of Commissioners voted to establish the Historic Neely School as a Rowan County Historical Landmark. Chairman Edds continued by saying the Historic Landmark Commission (HLC) had prepared a special plaque to be presented to the property owners, the Historic Neely School Foundation. The HLC requested the Board of Commissioners present the plaque.

Chairman Edds highlighted the following information about the Neely School:



- The Neely School is significant because of its purpose, age and cultural significance to Rowan County. Mr. Neely built the school on his land to educate his seven children (Annie, Cassie Bell, Mary, Jonas Winslow, Thomas, Henry Albert, and Julian) and the children of the Neelytown community.
- Julius Erastus Neely was an AME Zion minister and farmer.
- The school provided the only educational opportunity for African American children in the community.
- The county school superintendent promised to provide one teacher for the school if the school was built.
- The one room school house and the original footprint of the building we're designated as a local historic landmark.
- The school was in operation up until the 1940s.

Chairman Edds asked those in the audience who were attending for the special presentation to please stand. A round of applause followed the recognition.

Chairman Edds asked the Commissioners to join him in front of the dais to assist in the presentation and to also have a photograph taken with those attending on behalf of the HLC/Neely School Foundation.

# 3d. PROCLAMATION FOR CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

(This item was pulled from the Consent Agenda for discussion).

Commissioner Klusman talked about child abuse and how it is a learned behavior passed down from generation to generation.

Commissioner Klusman moved approval of a Proclamation for Child Abuse Prevention Month, which she read as follows:

WHEREAS, child maltreatment is a community problem and finding a solution depends upon involvement among people throughout the community; and

WHEREAS, child maltreatment occurs when parents find themselves in stressful situations without community resources and unable to cope; and

WHEREAS, approximately 127,199 children were reported abused and/or neglected in North Carolina in Fiscal Year 2017; and

WHEREAS, 32 children were victims of homicide due to abuse or neglect in North Carolina during the year 2015; and

WHEREAS, the majority of child maltreatment cases stem from situations and conditions that are preventable in an engaged and supportive community; and

WHEREAS, the effects of child maltreatment are felt by whole communities, and need to be addressed by the entire community; and

WHEREAS, effective child maltreatment prevention programs succeed because of partnerships created



among social service agencies, schools, faith communities, civic organizations, law enforcement agencies, and the business community.

THEREFORE, the Rowan County Commissioners, do hereby proclaim April 2018 as Child Abuse Prevention Month in Rowan County and call upon all citizens, community agencies, faith groups, medical facilities, and businesses to increase their participation in our efforts to prevent child maltreatment and strengthen the communities in which we live.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Pierce and passed unanimously.

# 4. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Chairman Edds opened the Public Comment Period to entertain comments from any citizens wishing to address the Board. The following individuals came forward:

- Reverend Dr. Fleming Otey, Chief of the Yadkin River Valley Indians for the area, invited the Board to the Mayors Spirit Luncheon, scheduled for April 25, 2018 at Salisbury City Hall. Rev. Otey said the Board would be presented with a special award at that time. Rev. Otey presented the board members with a \$5 gift card to Cracker Barrel.
- Ronnie Smith announced that on May 28, 2018 (Memorial Day) at 10:00 a.m. there would be a ceremony at the Veterans Cemetery Salisbury National Cemetery Annex (Annex). Mr. Smith invited the Board to attend the event. Mr. Smith provided the Board with a copy of a Resolution adopted by the City of Salisbury and asked the Board to consider adoption of a similar resolution in support of enlarging the Annex.
- Michael Julian said the County purchased the West End Plaza (WEP)
  approximately 5-6 years ago with the intent of allowing a mixed use of
  private enterprise/government. Mr. Julian felt the County was losing
  money by not leasing some of the vacant space as the County continued
  to spend money on the facility.
- Geoffrey Hoy provided the Board with a copy of a Resolution passed by the Democratic Party titled "Calling For A Pathway To Citizenship For Recipients Of Temporary Protective Status (TPS) In Rowan County North Carolina." Mr. Hoy asked the Board to consider adoption of the Resolution as there were approximately 8,000 residents in Rowan County that would be affected if TPS eligibility ended.
- Lilian Spears reported that on July 4, 2018 TPS would end for at least 8,000 residents in Rowan County. Ms Spears encouraged the Board to support some kind of immigration reform.
- Andrew Poston said Rowan County Sheriff Kevin Auten was to be commended for running such a good department. Mr. Poston highlighted several recent events for which he praised the Sheriff and his officers. The comments were followed by a round of applause.

With no one else wishing to address the Board, Chairman Edds closed the Public Comment Period.



# 5. NCDOT GRANT TO REPLACE THE AIRPORT INSTRUMENT LANDING SYSTEM

County Manager Aaron Church said the County had received word from the North Carolina Department of Transportation, Division of Aviation, there may be grant funds available to assist the County. Mr. Church said he had provided a letter back to the State letting them know Rowan County had the ability to support a 10% match for any of the grant funds.

Mr. Church requested the Board consider granting approval for the County to apply for an NCDOT grant for replacement of the Airport's current Instrument Landing System (ILS), which was over 21 years old. The total cost of the project was estimated to be \$540,000 and Rowan County would be responsible for 10% of the project cost. Mr. Church said the project was not budgeted for this year; however, the Airport Director was requesting the replacement in the next budget year. Mr. Church said in order to apply, Board approval was needed.

Commissioner Klusman moved, Commissioner Pierce seconded and the vote to give the County Manager approval to apply for the grant and to provide the 10% match passed unanimously.

Due to the operations of the North Carolina National Guard at the Airport, Commissioner Pierce felt it was imperative for the ILS to be replaced, whether grant funds were received or not.

# 6. LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL UPDATE

Planning Director Ed Muire provided a power point as he presented two (2) options for locating the Rowan County Law Enforcement Memorial (Memorial) on the grounds of the Rowan County Courthouse. Mr. Muire said once a location was selected, Staff would prepare an application for the site/monument's consideration by the Salisbury Historic Properties Commission (HPC).

Mr. Muire reported that bids were let in February and Salisbury Marble and Granite was selected to provide the service. The preferred recommended by staff was for Option A to the left of courthouse steps.

Staff's recommendation was also to:

- Authorize the County Manager and/or Staff to prepare and submit the Certificate of Appropriateness to the (HPC), including any related fees or signatures for processing
- Authorize the County Manager or Staff to obtain any necessary bids and select a contractor for incidental concrete and electrical (if needed) work related to the monument

Commissioner Pierce noted the importance of the Memorial and questioned if there had been conversations about placing it closer to the courthouse entrance. Mr. Muire said yes; however, staff did not want the Memorial to become an



attraction for vandalism nor for it to be climbed on. Commissioner Caskey added he felt the Memorial was close enough for people to see from the sidewalk and the proposed location also avoided potential utility issues.

- Commissioner Pierce moved to locate the monument in Plan A. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Klusman and passed unanimously.
- Chairman Edds moved to authorize the County Manager and/or Staff to prepare and submit the Certificate of Appropriateness to the (HPC), including any related fees or signatures for processing. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Pierce and passed unanimously.
- Chairman Edds moved to authorize the County Manager or Staff to obtain any necessary bids and select a contractor for incidental concrete and electrical (if needed) work related to the monument. Commissioner Greene seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

# 7. LAW ENFORCEMENT PAY TRENDS

County Manager Aaron Church said the County had learned some of its hiring rates for law enforcement may be out of date and not competitive with current pay trends. Mr. Church said the Sheriff had done a lot of research and found other agencies were giving bonuses and increasing pay. Mr. Church said there was a shortage of law enforcement officers.

Mr. Church said there were recent stories in the press where the City of Raleigh was recruiting officers from the City of Charlotte. In our own community, Mr. Church said the City of Salisbury had vacancies in the past but had worked on its recruitment efforts.

According to Mr. Church there was a fear that within the next year the County could start losing officers. Mr. Church described how the actual pay for officers was convoluted in comparisons as some agencies do not pay social security tax, the number of hours worked vary in a 30-day period, etc. Mr. Church said every agency paid its officers differently, even through vacation and sick leave benefits.

Mr. Church said the Sheriff was being proactive in trying to ensure Rowan County remained competitive and did not lose any of its officers. Mr. Church said he and the Sheriff felt it would be advantageous to retain consultants to assist the Sheriff's Office. Mr. Church reported Piedmont Triad Regional Council of Governments submitted a proposal to perform the study at a cost of \$12,000.

Sheriff Auten described his staff as a good group and stated his staff gets recruited all the time. Sheriff Auten said his fear was losing people more to Concord, Cabarrus or Mooresville. Sheriff Auten reiterated Mr. Church's comments with regards to how agencies pay their officers in different ways.



Sheriff Auten said he was told by another agency that Rowan County was not competitive with any agency.

Discussion ensued with regards to officers pay, dangers of the job and changes in society that will cause the issue to get worse instead of better.

Chairman Edds highlighted reduced crime statistics for Rowan County and said the Sheriff's Department had been a stabilizing force to Rowan County's communities. Chairman Edds also pointed out most of the Department consisted of local officers. Chairman Edds mentioned how the officers appreciate the opportunity to work for Sheriff Auten. In conclusion, Chairman Edds described it an honor to have Commissioner Caskey on the Board of Commissioners (Commissioner Caskey is also a law enforcement officer in Mecklenburg County). Chairman Edds said there had never been a time that Commissioner Caskey asked the Board for support that the Board had not acted. Chairman Edds said the Board needed to do better for Sheriff Auten.

Sheriff Auten expressed appreciation for the Board's support and for the kind words giving all the praise to his staff.

Commissioner Pierce moved to retain the Piedmont Triad Regional Council of Governments to perform a study at a cost of \$12,000. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Greene and passed unanimously.

## 8. FINANCIAL REPORT

Assistant County Manager/Finance Director Leslie Heidrick presented several graphs and updated the Board regarding the County's current financial status. The graphs depicted the following:

- Annual cumulative revenue for March 2018 \$109,858,642
- Expenditures as of March 2018 \$101,080,230
- Property tax collections as of February 2018 \$74,347,337
- Monthly sales tax as of December 2018 \$12,229,240

## 9. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF BUDGET AMENDMENTS

Finance Director Leslie Heidrick presented the following budget amendments for the Board's consideration:

- Finance To budget a One NC Fund Grant for Agility Fuel Systems -\$98.096
- Sheriff Recognize funds received from Federal Asset Forfeiture (US Customs and Border Forfeiture from 2017) - \$18,319

Commissioner Pierce moved approval of the budget amendments as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Klusman and passed unanimously.



# 10. REPORTS

Commissioner Pierce moved to accept the Community Child Protection Team Annual Report for 2017 as submitted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Greene and passed unanimously.

# 11. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Pierce moved to adjourn at 7:30 p.m. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Greene and passed unanimously.



#### **BACKGROUND**

On September 2, 1999, Planning Staff issued a zoning permit to property owners Paul and Kathy Beckham for a 4,600 sq.ft. personal use storage building (not for business) located at 11710

Bringle Ferry Road on tax parcel 507-039. To knowledge, no other permit requests were made regarding this site until January of 2011 when a contractor working for current property owner JEMM LLC. requested permits from the Environmental Health Office to install a new septic system. After learning JEMM's intensions of signing a lease agreement with Charles Blackwelder to operate a metal recycling facility, staff informed the owner the property would need to be rezoned to Industrial (IND) with a conditional use permit prior to operation.

In researching the site's history, it was discovered from Tax Assessors Office records, the Beckham's operated P&K mobile wash & equipment rental in late 1999 / early 2000. Since they lived on an adjacent parcel, this business may have met the Special Requirements (SR) to allow the operation but was permitted by both Staff and the Building Inspections Office as residential storage only. It is unknown what the building was used for between 2000 and 2011.

On May 2, 2011, the Board of Commissioners (BOC) approved the rezoning of tax parcel 507-039, totaling approximately 10 acres, from Rural Agricultural (**RA**) to Industrial with a Conditional Use District **IND-CUD** to accommodate a metal recycling facility.

**REQUEST** 

Mr. Blackwelder ceased operation around the spring of 2014 leaving the property idle until sometime in 2017. Initially, JEMM requested a modification to the existing **IND-CUD** district permitting only metal

recycling to **IND-CD** to permit a commercial fabricator of acrylic countertops, which is currently in operation. However, as a result of the Planning Board (PB) meeting both the owner and applicant elected to amend the request to Neighborhood Business (**NB**) instead of a modified **IND** district. With this change, all uses in district must be considered when evaluating this designation.

ZONING CRITERIA

#### 1. Relationship and conformity with any plans and policies.

Plans – This property is located in Area Two identified by the Land Use Plan for Areas East of I-85, which references instances of rural commercial and industrial uses that operate along thoroughfares. Neighborhood Business is generally considered an appropriate designation for "Rural Businesses" located along identified thoroughfares such as Bringle Ferry Road (major thoroughfare). Transitioning to **NB** could address plan recommendation "B" noted on page 27 of the plan, "Industrial land use applications are discouraged in the Planning Area except for existing industrial districts and those properties within the US 29 / I-85 and NC 152 highway corridors." It is worth noting, the initial rezoning in 2011 preceded the east plan adoption by eight (8) months.

Policies – N/A.

# 2. Consistency with the requested zoning district's purpose and intent.

Industrial, IND – "This district is intended to provide for industrial activities involving extraction, manufacturing, processing, assembling, storage, and distribution of products. The district is also designed to accommodate other, more intense nonresidential uses which generate adverse side effects such as noise, odor or dust. The district is typically applied in areas with maximum accessibility to major highways, rail lines, and other significant transportation systems. However this district may also exist or be created in an area other than listed in this subsection if the existing or proposed development is compatible with the surrounding area and the overall public good is served."

Neighborhood Business, NB – This district is designed for retail, limited small manufacturing facilities and service oriented business centers which serve small trading areas. As a result the list of allowed uses is more limited than those in the CBI district. The development standards for these business areas are designed to promote sound, permanent business development and to protect abutting and surrounding residential areas from undesirable aspects of nearby commercial development. This district is also designed to provide opportunities for potential development within the NB district. Areas zoned NB shall be so located as to conveniently serve the community population.

Areas zoned NB shall be so located as to conveniently serve the community population. The establishment and subsequent development of this district shall not create or expand problems associated with traffic volumes or circulation. As the district is established to provide for small neighborhood oriented business areas limitations on gross floor area is

established. Limitations on total impervious surface are established to minimize the adverse impacts of this type of development on adjacent residential areas. Generally, the NB district shall be two (2) acres or larger. However a lot of record, smaller than two (2) acres may be considered for rezoning to NB if the owner of the lot does not own adjacent property which may be included in the rezoning request.

Considering the land use plan recommendations, **NB** seems appropriate for the subject property. Migrating from **IND** would not only eliminate scrap metal recycling as a possible land use but would also remove the notion this area could be considered "industrial" should future landowners in the vicinity consider zone changes.

# 3. Compatibility of all uses within the proposed district classification with other properties and conditions in the vicinity.

<u>Compatibility of uses –</u> For comparison purposes, the below table of use excerpt provides a generalized comparison between the **IND-CUD** and **NB** districts.

Nearly all uses in the NB district are subject to the following standards:

- 1. Building size is limited to the lesser of 10% of the lot size or 10,000 sq.ft.
- 2. Maximum impervious surface shall not exceed sixty-five (65) percent of the lot.
- 3. Hours of operation shall not exceed 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- 4. Outdoor storage sited to the rear of the building, not within the setbacks, and completely screened from adjacent residentially zoned property.
- 5. Outdoor display limited to 2,500 sq.ft.

These limitations are designed to reduce potential impacts on adjoining properties and address compatibility in **NB** designations in more rural locations.

# Conditions in the vicinity (see enclosed map) –

Residential density is very low in the immediate area as most of the surrounding **RA** zoned acreage contains a thick coverage of evergreen and deciduous trees. The nearest **IND** zone is located 1.2 road miles west of this site containing a 9,800 sq.ft. race shop constructed in 1996 (pre-zoning) within the 5 ½ acre district. The Kountry Market, located 1.3 road miles east of from the site, represents the only other non-residential district within the vicinity. The five (5) acre **CBI-CUD** district contains a 4,000 sq.ft. convenience store constructed in 1945. Two (2) additional non-residential non-conforming structures, currently zoned RA, are located adjacent to the convenient store: a 900 sq.ft retail store constructed in 1952 and a 1,500 retail store constructed in 1977 (according to the Assessors Office Records).

#### 4. Potential impact on facilities such as roads, utilities and schools.

<u>Roads</u> – DOT traffic counts from 2016 received 800 feet east of the intersection of Surratt Road suggests an average daily traffic count of 1,300 trips per day compared to an estimated capacity of 15,100 trips by the DOT Comprehensive Transportation Plan for this section of Bringle Ferry Road. Since the estimated capacity is largely based on pavement width and speed limit, it should only be used as basic information regarding the volume to capacity ratio rather than the single measure in assessing the road's operational capability.

<u>Utilities & Schools – N/A.</u>

#### **DECISION MAKING**

In addition to the above criteria, sec. 21-362 (c) of the Zoning Ordinance indicates the primary question before the PB / BOC in a rezoning decision is "whether the proposed"

change advances the public health, safety, or welfare as well as the intent and spirit of the ordinance." Additionally, the boards "shall not regard as controlling any advantages or disadvantages to the individual requesting the change but shall consider the impact of the proposed zoning change on the public at large."

#### **PROCEDURES**

The BOC must develop a statement of consistency describing whether its action is consistent with any adopted comprehensive plans and indicate why their action is reasonable and in the public

interest [sec. 21-362 (j)]. A statement analyzing the reasonableness of the decision is also necessary. Recent adoption of Senate Bill 131 established a structured statement of consistency required for each zoning map and text amendment, which must take one of the following forms:

1. A statement approving the zoning amendment and describing its consistency with an adopted comprehensive plan and explaining why the action taken is reasonable and in the public interest;

- 2. A statement rejecting the zoning amendment and describing its inconsistency with an adopted comprehensive plan and explaining why the action taken is reasonable and in the public interest;
- 3. A statement approving the zoning amendment and containing at least all of the following:
  - a. A declaration that the approval is also deemed an amendment to the comprehensive plan;
  - b. An explanation of the change in conditions the board took into account amending the zoning ordinance to meet the development needs of the community;
  - c. Why the action was reasonable and in the public interest.

While no other specific guides were established to direct required content, guidance from the UNC School of Government suggests the "statements must be more than a checklist conclusion – it must include some modest discussion and explanation".

## MARCH 26<sup>TH</sup> PLANNING BOARD MEETING

Other than the applicant, no one was present at the courtesy hearing. PB members

discussed the benefits of recommending NB to the applicant and BOC vs. leaving the conditional district and IND designation. On a vote of 8-1, the board recommended approval of the request but recommended staff work with the applicant to modify the request to NB.

The PB recommended the following statements but were based on the conditional district request, which will need to be modified. Staff will prepare revised statements prior to the hearing.

Consistency - In accordance with section 21-361(b) of the Rowan County Zoning Ordinance, the Planning Board advises the Z 02-18 request is consistent with the Eastern Rowan Land Use Plan based on the following: The new use is a modification and improvement to the current IND-CUD district and removes the allowed use of metal recycling. The use of acrylic countertop fabrication is a more compatible less intrusive use. The request utilizes performance based standards to a single use to ensure compatibility with other uses.

<u>Reasonableness</u> - In accordance with section 21-362(j) of the Rowan County Zoning Ordinance and after due consideration advises the Z 02-18 request is reasonable with the Eastern Land Use Plan and in the public interest based on the following: The request is an improvement of the existing IND-CUD zoning district. The request is a reuse of an existing commercial structure.


This request would modify an existing **IND-CUD** district to exclude metal recycling in favor of a district recommended

by the eastern plan that could also serve as a practical district for future uses should the current cease operations cease.

Of the current conditions for the conditional district, it appears only condition #3 and 4 could be lost as the others have either already been satisfied or no longer apply.


### Current conditions of approval from the previous request are as follows:


- 1) Pave the driveway 50 feet.
- 2) Obtain and comply with commercial driveway permit from DOT.
- 3) Provide a type A buffer [along the property frontage].
- 4) Limit the operation to the front half of the property.
- 5) Comply with the change of use requirements from the Building Inspections Office.
- 6) All metal must be store in containers or within the existing building.
- 7) Any non-metal materials removed from items purchased must be disposed within an appropriate container, dumpster, or within the building and not stockpiled on the ground.
- 8) Add gravel around the outside storage container area.
- 9) Provide necessary measures to obtain a "no exposure exemption" from NCDENR's Industrial Stormwater Permit.

According to the School of Government, "the County Manager does not have automatic authority to refund fees, but the governing board can delegate this authority. The board must set the general contours for when fees will be refunded and the policy must be applied consistently by the manager." In November 2014, the Board of Commissioners delegated authority to the County Manager to refund any and all fees not to exceed \$1,000 per refund if the fee was paid in error, services were not received or the product was defective. The County is currently receiving some refund requests that meet these parameters, except they exceed \$1,000.

Staff's Recommendation: To provide expeditious and courteous service, it is the recommendation of the County Manager's Office and Finance Department that the County Manager's authority to refund any and all fees paid in error, paid for services not received or paid for defective products be increased from \$1,000 per refund to \$2,500 per refund.

SUBJECT: NON-BENEFITED PART-TIME EMPLOYEES' PAY

Currently some departments are having trouble filling part-time positions.

As it stands, management is only authorized to hire part-time employees the minimum pay rate. It would be very helpful if management had the latitude to offer up to 30% above the starting rate for part-time employees. Additionally, it would be helpful if management had the authority to adjust currently employed part-time employees pay this year for internal equity. Below are two examples where we are having trouble:

### Parks and Recreation

The Director of Parks and Recreation has conveyed that they are having trouble filling parttime positions at the Parks. These positions have been posted, but applicants are not applying, at least in part due to the low starting salary. The Parks are short staffed in the train and carousel areas. Currently they are advertising in the Salisbury Post for part-time park maintenance, train / carousel operators, gem mine and camp ground staff. Parks and Recreation is concerned that attractions may need to be closed if we do not have enough employees to operate the attractions.

### <u>Airport</u>

Over the past year, the Airport has had a difficult time filling our Aviation Service Worker I – Part-Time position. The position currently pays \$9.21 per hour; however, we have had a number of individuals turn down the position due to its hourly rate. Multiple applicants have stated the hourly rate is too low for a manual labor position. An increase in the hourly pay for this position will certainly have a positive outcome attracting and maintaining qualified employees.

### **MOTION**

Authorize the HR Director to approve an increase not to exceed 30% of the non-benefited part-time minimum pay rate and adjust currently employed non-benefited part-time employees' pay for internal equity.

This **TASK ORDER NO. 8** dated the \_\_\_\_\_\_, day of January 2018, is a supplement to the **MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT** between the Rowan County, North Carolina, dated February 19, 2016 hereinafter referred to as OWNER and McGill Associates, P.A., hereinafter referred to as "ENGINEER". The purpose of this Task Order is to authorize the ENGINEER to provide services for the "PROJECT" entitled: Proposed I-85 Interchange Water and Sewer Service Planning Services.

### SECTION 1 - PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project can generally be described as construction of water and sewer infrastructure to serve the proposed I-85 interchange (along the new alignment of Old Beatty Ford Road) to be constructed by NCDOT. It is assumed that Rowan County will own all of this proposed infrastructure, which will connect to existing Salisbury/Rowan Utilities infrastructure, and be maintained by Salisbury/Rowan Utilities, through an interlocal agreement.

All other deviations are subject to the variance process before the Board of Adjustment.

### **BACKGROUND**

On October 2, 2000, the Board of Commissioners approved a waiver request (**FSW 03-00**) from Linda Barber to exceed the administrative limit of three (3) lots plus the residual for family

subdivisions on her property located at the 13100 Block of Statesville Blvd. As a result, Ms. Barber created one lot each for her daughters Brenda Barber (lot 2) and Sherry Dunlap (lot 3) and a third lot for her son Eric Barber (lot 4) [see enclosed recorded plat]. A fourth lot was established for herself (lot 1) along with retaining the residual 9.2 acres labeled on the plat as "remainder".

At that time, the Subdivision Ordinance recognized the waiver process generically as a means for the Board of Commissioners to "waive" requirements from the family subdivision requirements "when, in its opinion, undue hardship may result from strict compliance."

### **REQUEST**

In March 2018, Planning Staff met with members of the Barber family interested in purchasing lot 4, which is currently owned by Linda Barber's son Charles Barber along with the portion of land labeled as

"remainder". According to the enclosed request from Charles, he would like to sell lot 4 to his cousin William Junior Cherry, the nephew of Linda Barber (Magdline Baker is Linda's sister and mother to William). According to Charles, Mrs. Baker does not own land that could be given for him to build a home.

In 2016, the Commissioners amended the Subdivision Ordinance to specify family subdivision waivers could be used in two (2) instances: where lots would be conveyed to family members outside the definition of immediate family (e.g. aunts / uncles, nieces / nephews, and cousins) and for requests of more than four (4) total lots established. All other deviations are subject to the variance process before the Board of Adjustment.

Approving **FSW 01-18** would allow the conveyance of lot 4 to a cousin of the current owner or nephew to the original owner (subdivider).

### **EVALUATION**

As provided in Section 22-54, the BoC may authorize a waiver from the family subdivision requirements when, in its opinion, undue hardship may result from strict compliance. In granting

any waiver, the Board of Commissioners shall consider the following:

- **1. Nature of the proposed subdivision.** Lot 4 is an existing 2 acre undeveloped parcel established by the June 22, 2002 Barber plat.
- **2.** Existing use of the land in the vicinity. Properties to the east and west are heavily wooded with a small concentration of housing north and south of Statesville Blvd.
- **3.** The number of persons to reside or work in the proposed subdivision. This waiver would allow for the construction of one (1) residence on Lot 4 for William Cherry.
- **4.** Probable effect of the proposed subdivision upon traffic conditions in the vicinity. NCDOT approved driveway permit number 02-024-RD on June 20, 2002 to serve the above referenced properties.

Section 22-54 indicates "The waiver shall be granted only when it has been determined that such waiver shall not be detrimental to the county and the areas surrounding the subdivision".

#### STAFF COMMENTS

Since the original division in 2002, the Barber family has maintained the 16.77 acre property in their ownership. Both daughters received their respective lots and

constructed residences while the lot reserved for her son Eric went to her other son Charles instead. The waiver process was established for a request such as this.



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
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

At the time that brought the budget to 320,434. Technically the amount to draw down is 322,169 and we will draw down all SSBG funding.


